Additional Charges and Extras			
- <b>Flexi-boarding:</b> day pupils may board, subject to availability, for £49 per night.			
- <b>Music:</b> Individual instrumental tuition at £184 per term. Instrument hire charges available on request.			
- <b>Speech and Drama:</b> £16.00 per session for Pre-Prep and £17.50 per session for Prep.			
- <b>Learning Support:</b> Individual tuition at £24 per half-hour session.			
- <b>Options:</b> Specialist options (e.g. Horseriding) with external providers charged at rates agreed separately.			
- <b>Trips, Visits and Activities:</b> The cost of a trip, visit or activity will be added to the bill. If you signed the consent form no further action is required on trips or activities where the charge is below £30.			
- <b>After School Care (Pre-preparatory only):</b> The first session runs until 5pm and is charged at £6.00. The second session runs from 5-6pm and is charged at £9.80 as it includes tea. Charges apply for a session or part thereof.			
- <b>School Bus Runs:</b> There are a number of minibus runs each day (currently morning only) from various locations. Please contact Julie Burdett in the Bursary to ask about capacity from your location.			
- <b>Bilton Record:</b> the School magazine is published annually and all parents will be charged for their copy.			
- <b>Personal Effects Insurance:</b> Opt-in to the Scheme. Details available on request.			
- <b>School Fees Protection Scheme:</b> Opt-in to the Scheme. Details available on request.			
Remissions			
- <b>Service personnel:</b> Parents who are serving with HM Forces will receive a minimum discount of 15% of the boarding fee.			
- <b>Siblings:</b> Parents with 3 children at Bilton Grange will receive a remission of 15% of fees on the eldest child. Parents with 4+ children at Bilton Grange will receive a remission of 40% of fees on the eldest child.			
- <b>Bursaries:</b> Means tested bursaries may be available. Application Forms are available from <a href="mailto:funding@rugbyschool.net">funding@rugbyschool.net</a> .			
- Please note that any remission may be varied if a scholarship or bursary is given.			

**Notes:**

- Fees are due in full by the first day of term unless paid under a direct debit.
- The School reserves the right to charge interest on overdue accounts at 2% over its banker's base rate.
- A full term's fees is due if a child is withdrawn without a full term's notice, in writing, to the Headmaster.
- Fees include:
  - For Day Pupils – all lunches and (for Preparatory department pupils) teas on normal School days.
  - For Full Boarders – all meals on normal School days and weekends, normal laundry.
  - For Weekly Boarders – all meals excluding Saturday tea and all Sunday meals, normal laundry.
  - Books and stationery used by children (except music books).
- Children aged under five at the start of the term are entitled to 15 hours a week free-of-charge provided by Warwickshire County Council under the Early Education Funding Entitlement. See separate notice for these fees.
