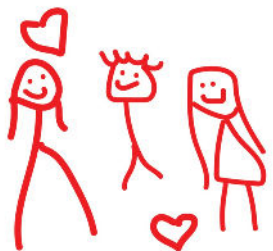

About FAB

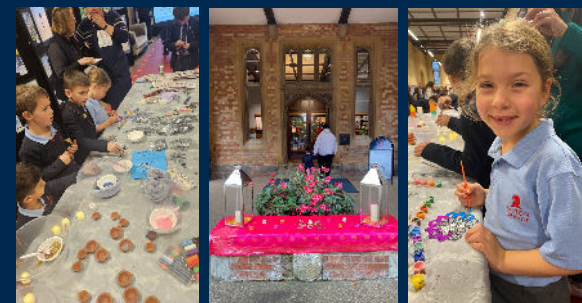

Diwali Celebrations 15th October

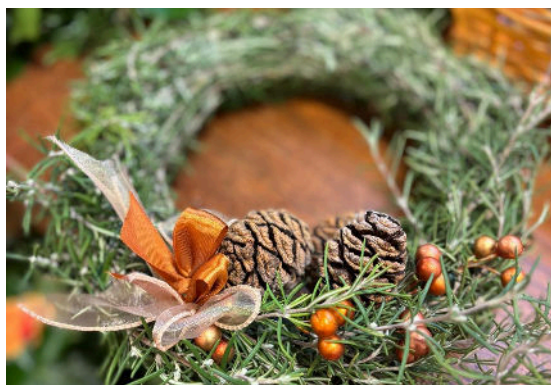
