- Opening Times and Dates: the School’s normal opening hours for Nest children are from 8am-4pm Monday to Friday during term time:		
- Advent Term: 1 September to 11 December 2026		
- Lent Term: 5 January to 24 March 2027		
- Trinity Term: 19 April to 2 July 2027		
Important Notes		
- Sessions: The Nest operates with a minimum requirement of three sessions per week . Parents may choose to do either morning sessions, afternoon sessions or full days. A full day will count as two sessions.		
- Childcare Vouchers: We are registered to receive payment by child-care vouchers and from tax-free childcare accounts. Please contact the Bursary for further details.		
- Wrap Around Care: Supervision from 8am-8.20am and from 3.30pm-4pm is free of charge.		
- After School Care (Pre-preparatory only): The first session runs until 5.00pm and is charged at £10. The second session runs from 5.00pm-6.00pm and is charged at £14.00 as it includes tea. Charges apply for a session or part thereof. Early Birds Breakfast from 7.30am-8.00am is on offer in Pre-Prep at a cost of £10.		
- Additional Items: All food during the regular session times, disposables, sun cream and similar consumables are generally provided without any additional charge to those attending the class, whether on funded only places or not.		

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- Parents are welcome to supply their own consumables and the School will seek to use these if so requested. If parents have particular nutritional needs for their children and a desire to provide for them separately, they should discuss these with the nursery and we will seek to accommodate these needs within the constraints of our staffing and allergen policies.
- We do not charge separately for any activities or options that might take place during Funded Hours.
- **Trips, Visits and Activities:** The cost of a trip, visit or activity will be added to the bill. If you signed the consent form no further action is required on trips or activities where the charge is below £30. Trips and visits will usually not be subject to VAT. If the event takes place between 8.20-11.20am, the School will confirm participation with parents first, with the cost of the trip or visit communicated to parents in advance. Parents will have the right of opt out in such cases.
- **WCC Free Entitlement to 15 Hours:** All parents of children aged 3 or more are entitled to 15 free hours of childcare for 32 weeks per annum under the Early Education Funding Entitlement. The 15 free hours are available daily from 8.20am to 11.20am. Parents wishing to take up their funded entitlement only should contact the Admissions department for availability as there are a limited number of such places available.
- **Enhanced Provision:** There will be a daily short session of a focused, taught activity each morning, such as Rhythm Time, Create Club, Sports Stars, STEAM and Outdoor Learning. The sessions are optional and their daily cost is included in the full session price above.
- **Due Payment Dates:** Fees are due in full by the first day of term unless paid under a direct debit. The School reserves the right to charge interest on overdue accounts at 2% over the school's bank's base rate.
- **Notice for Change:** A full term's fees are due if a child is withdrawn or sessions reduced without a full term's notice, in writing, to the Headmaster.
- **Term Lengths:** typical term lengths are based on 32 weeks a year split into three terms.
- In determining the above termly charges, we have factored in that there may be half days for Exeats (twice a term), Half-Terms and End of Terms. We also operate a staggered start policy at the beginning of the Advent Term for the new Nest cohort which includes some half days to facilitate the children settling in a new environment. No further discounts will be offered in relation to these.
- **Terms and Conditions:** Please see the School's Terms and Conditions for further information about the payment of fees and extras. Copies are available on request from the Bursary. Please note in particular that a full term's fees are due if a student is withdrawn without a full term's notice, in writing, to the Head.
- **VAT:** Please note that no VAT is due on pre-Reception school fees.
